BOAT PERMITS

All existing vessels located below the Duke-Progress Energy property line are expected to have a current permit. Typically if a boat is found with an older permit, you will be expected to pay the permit fees for the lapsed year or face a citation. The cost for a Hyco Lake annual boat permit is \$50. Any boat **operating** on Hyco Lake is expected to have a valid yearly or daily permit—this includes boats owned by leaseholders. Homeowners are responsible for all vessels located on or below their leased area. Boats that remain on boat lifts and are not in use have a grace period until June 1st of the current year to display a valid permit. **Any violations of the above will subject the owner to a citation. As of this printing, the current cost of court is \$180, so having a current permit is the better choice of the two.** Boat Permits are **NOW** available by mail and phone. You can mail your payment to Person-Caswell Lake Authority at PO Box 343, Roxboro, NC 27573 or call with your credit or debit card (336-599-4343) and we can assist you. There will be a \$5 handling charge per permit by mail and phone.
